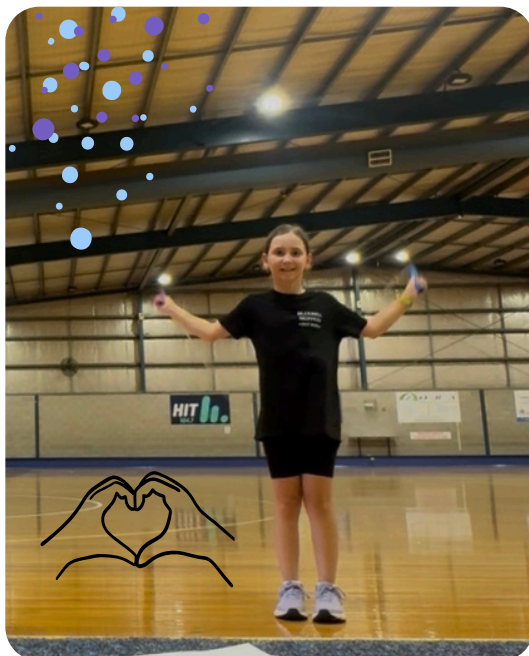

Sophie is always dedicated and shows up with a positive attitude, both of which are demonstrated by how much she has improved in such a short amount of time!

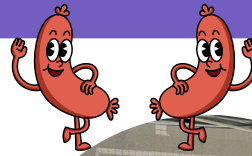
We love having her at training - she is always a bright light of kindness, encouraging everyone around her.

# EVENTS

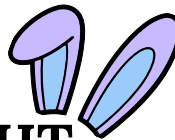
## BUNNINGS BBQ X2

We now have over \$320 worth of 10c cans! This is such a huge milestone, thank you to everyone who has donated. Keep those cans coming!



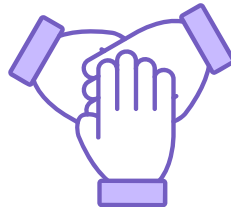
